

Health Care Pharmaceutical Waste Management Workshop

The workshop is designed to provide practical implementation steps to be in compliance with the hazardous waste regulations applicable to health care pharmaceutical and bio medical waste. Guidance documents developed by the Michigan Health & Hospital Association's Green Health Care Pharmaceutical Advisory Committee with assistance from the Department of Environmental Quality on Trace and Bulk Chemotherapy Waste and Universal Waste will be discussed. The documents are not new regulations for health care but will be a tool and Best Management Practice (BMP) documents which health care facilities can use to guide through existing applicable hazardous and bio medical waste regulations. Facilities are not bound to follow these BMPs. This is a reference only. The workshop is intended for health care pharmacists, registered nurses and other clinical staff, environmental services, compliance and safety directors and other facilities handling pharmaceutical wastes.

A total of 5.0 hours of Pharmacy Continuing Education Credit (PCE) has been applied for through the State of Michigan Board of Pharmacy. Credit will be earned based on full participation in the individual programs. Attendance and participation in a session are required before obtaining PCE credit. Any individual who joins the program late and/or leaves early will not be granted PCE credits. Participants must complete a program evaluation form and post test for each program to receive PCE credit.

A total of 5.0 Nursing Education credit has been applied for through the Detroit Medical Center (OH-292,5/1/2014) an approved provider of continuing nursing education by the Ohio Nurses Association (OBN-001-91), an accredited approver by the American Nurses Credentialing Centers Commission on Accreditation.
